AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for regular bail in case FIR 252 dated 13.05.2015, registered under Sections 323, 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station, Assandh, Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioner have been in custody since 14.05.2015. No injury has

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been attributed to them. This is a cross-version case wherein the other party has also been charged for offence under Section 307 IPC and the person who has alleged to have fired the shot is Seo Ram, who is in custody.

Learned Deputy Advocate General and the learned counsel on behalf of the complainant have accepted this factual assertion, but argued that the petitioner was one of the main conspirators. The petitioner along and other accused were in illegal possession of Panchayat land which was allotted to Schedule caste persons of the village and a Panchayat meeting was convened to discuss that issue. In that meeting, the petitioners along with other accused came with full preparation and shot the Sarpanch.

Keeping in view the arguments of learned counsel for both the sides, without commenting upon the merits of the case as well as the period of custody suffered by the petitioners and the role attributed to the petitioners, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

This petition stands disposed of.
