The above said petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to not to harass the petitioner at the behest of respondent No. 5 and further not to call the petitioner to the Police Station, without taking recourse to Chapter XII of the Cr.P.C.

On notice, a reply dated 05.01.2015 has been filed by DSP Sub Divn. Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur stating therein that the application submitted by respondent No. 5 was marked to SHO P.S Mahilpur, Distt. Hoshiarpur for enquiry. In the enquiry, it was found that the petitioners had misappropriated the amount of Rs.77,50,743/- and also misappropriated the record of the college regarding this misappropriation of amount. Accordingly after due enquiry, F.I.R No. 130 dated 01.12.2014 under Sections 406/420 IPC was registered against the petitioners. After completion of investigation, final report will be presented in the trial Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Budh Singh has informed the Court that Santokh Singh was arrested on 03.12.2014

In view of the detailed reply filed in the present petition, the present petitions have become infructuous.
