Above-referred petitions are being disposed of by this
common order being connected to each other.

By way of Crl. Misc. No. M-3157 of 2015, petitioner
Ashu Shukla and one other are seeking quashing of FIR No. 99
dated 03.09.2013, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506,
148, 149 IPC, Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana.

Petitioners Karan Sood and two others had filed Crl. Misc. No. M-
3391 of 2015 and are seeking quashing of cross-version DDR

No.20 dated 15.09.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324, 379, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana, arising out of the aforesaid FIR and consequent proceedings taken therein, on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received from the trial court after recording statements of the parties on compromise. Trial Court has also sent statements of parties recorded by it, which reveal that compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

Learned State counsel submits that the parties in both the petitions are the persons involved in the FIR and cross-version DDR.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR and DDR pending.

In view of the statements made by the parties and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR(Crl.) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303**, the instant petitions are allowed and the aforesaid FIR and the cross-version DDR recorded therein and consequent proceedings conducted therein are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
