1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking certain reliefs against the respondents No.3 to 11.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioners have also moved complaint dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the respondent No.2-S.S.P., SAS Nagar, Mohali and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide their complaint within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali is directed to look into

the matter/complaint (Annexure P-5) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law. .

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
