JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Abhishek Sharma in case FIR No.191 dated 15.11.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 380 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

As per allegations the petitioner being an employee of the complainant has misused the provisions of a scheme applicable to the customers and thereby loss to the tune of Rs.5 lac to the complainant. He is also alleged to have lifted a diary containing transactions of the complainant with his customers.

It is contended that the allegations are mis-placed and as a counter blast to the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable

Instruments Act, filed by the petitioner in the year 2014. It is further contended that no loss has been caused since similar transactions had taken place in the case of other distributors in relations to their customers.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raghbir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and since the evidence is primarily documentary evidence, his custodial interrogation is not required. He further states that challan has not been presented in the aforesaid FIR.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 17th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
