RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 287 dated 22.06.2014, under Sections 452/354/323/506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Nakodar City, District Jalandhar.

Dispute between the landlord and tenant is the root cause of this FIR. The petitioner has filed a civil suit for permanent injunction restraining his landlord from interfering in his peaceful possession. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of MLR (P-8) with regard to the injuries suffered by his wife.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent-State in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Nakodar, has been filed, wherein it has been stated that the MLR submitted by Iqbal Kaur, wife of the petitioner, was got verified, whereupon it was found that she had

not received any injury from the complainant. No action was taken on the representation made by her, as she had made an attempt to get a cross version registered.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that in compliance with the order dated 26.09.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation on 08.10.2014.

Since the petitioner has already joined the investigation, the order dated 26.09.2014 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
