JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.255 dated 14.06.2014, registered under Section 498-A, 302, 304-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC'), at P.S. Hathin, Distt. Palwal.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners are sisters-in-law of the deceased. Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are married and staying at Rajasthan, whereas, petitioner No.3 is unmarried. The petitioners were kept in column No.2. They have now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to face trial.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are the sisters-in-law of the deceased and were kept in column No.2, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to appear before the learned trial Court within a week from today, which shall admit them to bail, on their furnishing bail bonds/surety to its satisfaction.
