On account of petitioners having not attended the date of hearing on August 21, 2015, non-bailable warrants were issued raising the apprehension of arrest.

It has been argued that wrong date had been noticed by the petitioners as wrongly conveyed by the Clerk of the counsel.

The ground mentioned does not inspire confidence of the Court regarding the reason for non-appearance, however, in the interest of expeditious disposal of the trial, notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Randhawa, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice. Copy given.

Without entering into the controversy regarding the sufficiency of reasons for non-appearance on the date of hearing, in the interest of justice, this petition is disposed of in limine directing the petitioners to appear before the trial Court on or before October 12, 2015 and in case of their doing so, they will be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the said Court. In case the petitioners fail to appear on the said date and furnish bail bonds, this petition will be deemed to have been dismissed.
