JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.130 dated 16.08.2015, under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 188 and 283 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda **(Annexure P-1)**.

As per the allegations, on 15.08.2015, the villagers of Dyalpura including two petitioners and members of the Kisan Union held a demonstration on a highway and while blocking the road and causing hindrance to smooth running of traffic, also pelted brick bats and caused injuries to three police Constables.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1-Shinder Pal Kaur is housewife and petitioner No. 2-Major Singh suffers from Polio and they have not been named qua pelting stones and causing injuries to the injured police officials.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of previous order dated 16.09.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Jaswinder Singh, does not controvert the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, interim order dated 16.09.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
