Priya Rani and Mandeep Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent Nos. 5 and 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent nos. 5 and 6. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively.

Petitioner No.1 is said to be a widow and her husband had died in June 2015. It is her second marriage. The petitioners have approached straightway to this Court without making any representation to the police.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation to be made by the petitioners, expeditiously and as per law.
