Report dated 20.2.2015 sent by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Lakhwinder Singh, Harjeet Kaur, Mangal Singh and Akhwinder Kaur as well as of complainant Harinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was purely money dispute between the parties which has now been settled by way of compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.18 dated 10.04.2013 under Section 420, 120-B IPC Police Station, Haryana, District Hoshiarpur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
