The petitioner was found distilling illicit liquor by a working still. A boiler containing 10 kg of Lahan, 360 ml of liquor from the receiver bottle, and a plastic cane containing two bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from him.

The report of the District Probation Officer, Mansa was called for. The office has reported that the said report has not been received.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a certificate issued by Police Station Boha, District Mansa stating therein that there is no case registered against the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the totality of the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of releasing the petitioner on probation in terms of judgment of this Court in ***Buta Singh Vs.***

State of Punjab 2004(3) RCR (Crl.) 914. The petitioner is ordered to

be released on probation of good conduct, for a period of one year, on furnishing requisite bonds with one surety in a sum of Rs.20,000/- to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa undertaking to keep the peace and be of good behavior during the aforesaid period. Bonds will be furnished within a period of two months on receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case of failure of petitioner furnishing the above said bonds, the present revision petition will be deemed to have been dismissed and consequently, the petitioner would be liable to undergo the remaining sentence awarded by the courts below.

The revision petition is disposed of in the above manner.
