RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of the respondents, petitioner approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking appropriate directions against the respondent authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he repeatedly approached the respondent authorities, including by way of his representation which was forwarded by the Hon'ble Cabinet Minister of Government of India on 29.05.2015 to Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar but the said representation is also pending decision, as no action, to the knowledge of the petitioner, has been taken so far. He further submits that petitioner will be satisfied, in case Inspector General of Police, Hisar is directed to consider the matter and take an appropriate action, within reasonable time.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner at considerable length and without expressing any opinion on the merits, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Inspector General of Police, Hisar Range, Hisar is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance raised by the petitioner in his representation, already forwarded to him by the Hon'ble Cabinet Minister of Government of India on 29.05.2015 and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
