R.P. NAGRATH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.434 dated 22.09.2009 for offence under Sections 420, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala, based on compromise.

Report from the trial Court has been received after recording statements of parties, alongwith copies of statements. It is reported that compromise is voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bharat Bhushan submits that the petitioner is the only accused in this FIR and respondent No.2 is the only aggrieved person.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the parties have been settled their all disputes and property has also been partitioned.

No useful purpose would be served in continuing with the proceedings in this case in view of the compromise arrived at between them.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgement of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 (P&H)*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012)10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.434 dated 22.09.2009 for offence under Sections 420, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala and the subsequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof, are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements.
