RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeks quashing of the complaint (Annexure P-11) as well as summoning order dated 11.12.2014 (Annexure P-12).

It is undisputed before this Court that petitioner has not availed his remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order. No exceptional case has been made out, permitting the petitioner to by pass the remedy of revision. In such a situation, petitioner has not been found entitled for invoking the inherent jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. when a specific, equally efficacious and alternative remedy is available to the petitioner, under the Code of Criminal Procedure itself.

In view of the above, petitioner is relegated to his alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.
