Having absented on August 25, 2015, non-bailable warrants have been issued by the trial Court against the petitioner. Apprehending arrest, the petitioner filed an application for pre-arrest bail which has been dismissed by the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon medical certificate annexure P-2 indicating that the petitioner was not well on the date of hearing.

In the interest of justice and for expeditious disposal of the trial, without expression of any opinion regarding the sufficiency / in-sufficiency of the ground for non-appearance, I deem it appropriate to give an opportunity to the petitioner to put in appearance before the Court and face the trial so that the case may be finally decided at an early stage.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner will put in appearance before the trial Court on or before October 1, 2015, the date already fixed, and in case of his doing so, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the said Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will not absent himself without any sufficient cause during the entire period of trial and will not misuse the concession of bail.
