FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 06.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Dilpreet Kaur, Harjinder Singh and Phooljit Kaur as well as of complainant Balraj Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a matrimonial dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.195 dated 17.12.2014 under Sections 420, 380 IPC, Police Station, Sadar Ludhiana and all other

consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
