TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 05.03.2014, under Sections 307/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh would apprise the Court that apart from the Investigating Officer and the Doctors, all the other material witnesses have since been examined.

In view of the fact that trial in the matter has progressed and is now at the final stage, this Court is not inclined to grant to the petitioner the benefit of regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

It is, however, observed that the trial Court shall make every endeavor to finalize the trial proceedings and in any case, to conclude the same within a period of six months.
