By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.277, dated 07.08.2014, registered under Sections 452, 342, 380, 447 and 511 IPC, at Police Station Ambala City.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR. They have been falsely implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Harpal Singh. No specific role has been attributed to the petitioners. In pursuance of the order dated 16.09.2014, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, submits that in pursuance of

the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.09.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
