FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 03.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jagraon has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Ranjeet Singh as well as of complainant Harpreet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is non-injury case and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.57 dated 17.06.2015 under Sections 336,506,34,120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54,59 of Arms Act, Police

Station, City Raikot, District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
