JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.315 dated 29.08.2015, under Sections 379, 188 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Tauru, District Mewat.

As per the allegations, the petitioner is owner of a JCB machine, which has been used for committing theft of stones from the Panchgava Hills comprising part of the Aravali range wherein mining has been specifically banned under the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

It is submitted that the petitioner is involved in the illegal mining.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Surender Kumar, submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required for completing the chain of investigation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
