Petitioner No.1 is present in the Court. She dis-owns the averments in the petition stating that she was compelled to sign the petition and make averments under the threat, coercion and undue influence. She states that there is no threat to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents and that she is presently staying with her parents.

In view of said circumstances, the present petition on the ground mentioned therein is not maintainable and has rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for petitioner No.2 has submitted that petitioner No.2 may be granted protection against false implications. It will be open to petitioner No.2 to avail any legal remedy available to him in accordance with law.

The present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous without prejudice to the right of petitioner No.2 in any other petition or any litigation.
