Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in DDR No.31 dated 02.09.2014 under Sections 326, 447, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in FIR No.110 dated 31.08.2014 under Sections 307, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 30, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Deep Singh, Police Station Sardulgarh, Mansa, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.
