Petitioners had allegedly duped the complainant for sum of Rs.8,25,000/- on the pretext of sending him abroad on work visa.

Matter having been compromised, the present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR and the criminal proceedings. The affidavit of the complainant that the matter has been compromised stand already handed over to the investigating officer.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating officer to record the supplementary statement of the complainant within a period of one month and take up decision to file cancellation report. It is made clear that in case of cancellation report having been presented, the complainant would be required to furnish his no objection to the cancellation. In said eventuality, cancellation report would be accepted.
