This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.264 dated 30.06.2014 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sampla District Rohtak.

The allegation in the FIR is that amount of sale consideration was paid to Anguri Devi.

Counsel for the State on instructions from SI Balraj Singh has informed this Court that Rs.21 lacs have been recovered from Anguri Devi and she is on regular bail. Co-accused Anil Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail in CRM-M-27006-2014, which is made absolute. Pursuant to the order dated 19.09.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation. The petitioner has neither a witness to the sale deed nor he has received any sale consideration.

In view of the said fact, the order dated 19.09.2014 passed by

this Court is made absolute till the presentation of the challan and thereafter the petitioner shall furnish fresh bail/surety bonds before the Magistrate, which shall be accepted by the Magistrate to its satisfaction.

Disposed of accordingly.
