Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.192 dated 04.07.2015 under Sections 307, 452, 354, 506, 447, 511, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that parties have arrived at an amicable settlement by way of compromise deed (Annexure P-3). She also places reliance on an order dated 24.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by this court, whereby some co-accused of the petitioner were granted the concession of bail pending trial on the basis of this very compromise.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagbansh, Police Station City Tarn Taran, submits that compromise has taken place between the parties.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

Disposed of, accordingly.
