Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.30 dated 30.03.2015, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Jasleen Kaur alleging that she was married to petitioner No.1 on 20.11.2011. She had been maltreated by the petitioner No.1 and his family members.

Complainant-respondent No.2 has filed reply by appearing in person in the Court. Complainant-respondent No.2 and her father have stated that proceedings having already been initiated on the basis of compromise, they have got no objection in quashing of the FIR.

Challan has not been presented. Statement of complainant-respondent No.2 Jasleen Kaur recorded. In her statement, she has stated that she has compromised the matter with accused persons-petitioners. Complainant-respondent No.2 and her father have got no objection in case the FIR against the petitioners is quashed.

Investigating officer has informed that none of the petitioners is proclaimed offender and that they had been granted the concession of bail.

In view of statement of Jasleen Kaur, who has been identified by her counsel, I am satisfied that the matter has been compromised.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the terms and conditions being complied with by the petitioners. It is made clear that in case the terms and conditions of the compromise are not adhered to by the petitioners, it will be open to the complainant to file an application to re-open the criminal proceedings against the petitioners.
