NAVITA SINGH, J.

The petitioner was arrested for being found in possession of intoxicant powder, quantity of which was 100 grams. According to the FSL report, the ingredient was diphenoxylate hydrochloride, which was commercial quantity.

However, a separate case was registered against the father of the petitioner and one labourer from their field and both of them are on bail.

There is no other case against the petitioner and he is in custody since 08.06.2014. Two witnesses out of six have been examined and, therefore, trial is likely to take some time to conclude.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
