Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Diljeet Singh & Harjinder Kaur in case FIR No.96 dated 22.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Mukatsar Sahib.

As per the allegations the son and mother(duo)-petitioners had received a sum of Rs.1,20,000/- towards part payment of the demanded Rs.3 lac for sending the son of the complainant Buta Singh abroad on obtaining of a Visa. Neither the son of the complainant got Visa nor he was sent abroad and same resulted into lodging of the aforesaid FIR.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that compromise between the parties has been affected and in the petition bearing CRM-M No.23163 of 2015 filed for quashing the FIR on the basis of the said compromise, the statements of the parties have been recorded on 4.8.2015 and the said petition for quashing is now listed for 30.10.2015.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Amrik Singh concedes that the petitioners have joined the investigation and stated that parties have compromised the matter.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 09th of September, 2015 is hereby confirmed.

Petition stands disposed of.
