SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action against respondents No. 4 to 8.

Heard.

Petitioner had taken loan from respondents No. 4 and 5-finance company to the tune of ₹ 9,06,413/-. However, petitioner committed default in payment of installments.

During the course of arguments, it has transpired that petitioner had committed default to the tune of ₹ 1,56,000/- and due to this reason, the truck in question was taken in possession by the respondents-finance company. Admittedly, till date, petitioner has not paid the installments upto date.

Since the petitioner had committed default in payment of installments, no ground for interference by this Court is made out.
