Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Harsimran Singh @ Sammar in case FIR No.181 dated 29.11.2014 for offences punishable under Section 376, 511 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 67 of the IT Act and Section 8 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered with Police Station B Division, District Amritsar.

As per allegations the petitioner is alleged to have taken objectionable photographs of the daughter of the complainant.

It is contended that the alleged victim was a regular visitor to the house of the petitioner being a friend of his sister. From the allegations

it is nowhere suggested that any objectionable photographs were taken. Still further it is submitted that the alleged objectionable photographs have never seen the light of the day.

At the time of hearing counsel for the parties submit that their clients have arrived at a settlement.

The accused boy (22 years old) is present in Court has also filed an undertaking dated 24.12.2015, taken on record that henceforth he will not do any act which may even remotely harm the girl or the family.

In view of the stand of the petitioner, learned Counsel for the complainant has no objection if the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.09.2015 is made absolute.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 19th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
