JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.265 dated 16.08.2014, under Section 20 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered with Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

There is alleged recovery of 1 Kg. and 350 Gms. of *Charas* from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

The quantity of recovery is commercial in nature.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 16.08.2014.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, submits that 12 out of 13 prosecution witnesses have since been examined and, therefore, the trial being at the fag end, prays for dismissal of the present petition.

In the light of the recovery being commercial and the trial is at the fag end, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
