Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail inter alia on the ground that the most material witnesses allegedly present on the spot have turned hostile.

Counsel for the petitioner has not been able to produce the statements of complainant Ritu or eye witness Simranjit Kaur.

On asking of the Court, learned State counsel informs that the case is fixed for final disposal on 18.12.2015 as the entire evidence has already been produced by the prosecution agency.

Taking into consideration the penultimate stage of the trial, without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of expecting that the trial would be concluded within a period of 15 days after the next date of hearing i.e. 18.12.2015 in the present case. In case the trial is not concluded expeditiously as mentioned hereinabove, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again by producing statements of the witnesses already made in the Court on oath.
