Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 27.08.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sandaur, Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 19.09.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the complainant is the sister of the petitioners. Now, the mutation which was sanctioned in favour of the petitioners on the basis of the alleged forged gift deed has been cancelled. In fact, the FIR in question had been got registered by the complainant against the petitioners as the petitioners had filed a civil suit for permanent injunction against the complainant.

Notice of motion for 17.11.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Jagar Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 19.09.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
