FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.201 dated 17.8.2015 under Sections 409,407,420,380 IPC Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over to the learned counsel for the respondent-PUNSUP, a demand draft bearing No.689103 dated 01.12.2015 amounting to sum of ₹1,98,377/- drawn in the name of District Manager, PUNSUP in the light of previous order. Copy of the same is taken on record.

The allegations against the petitioner in this anticipatory bail application are that while posted as PUNSUP Inspector at Shahkot the petitioner has caused financial loss to the

tune of ₹1,98,377/- by embezzling the wheat from the godown of the PUNSUP. The petitioner to show his bonafide has deposited the exact amount of financial loss so accrued to the petitioner. Since the recovery has already been effected from the petitioner and that culpability, if any, shall be decided at the time of trial. Thus, the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that he will abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
