Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Ranjit Singh son of Balwinder Singh resident of Nathuwala Garbi, District Moga, now confined in sub-jail Moga, in case FIR No. 82, dated 19.06.2013, for offence under Sections 419/420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga on the basis of compromise Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said compromise has been effected between the complainant-Harjit Singh and petitioner-Ranjit Singh.

Mr. N.S. Dhandiwal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and admit the factum of compromise entered between the complainant-Harjit Singh and petitioner-Ranjit Singh.

Learned counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner-Ranjit Singh son of Balwinder Singh, is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
