The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.187, dated 18.7.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 411 of the IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in this case of Magisterial trial, the petitioner has now been in custody for two months and the only allegation against him is that he purchased a stolen car.

Learned Addl. A.G Punjab has argued that the petitioner is a conspirator with Gurmeet Singh who is the main accused.

This fact has been denied by counsel for the petitioner.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the

case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
