The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of regular bail in case FIR No. 17, dated 30.01.2013, under Sections 302, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar City.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh apprises the court that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, 13 have been examined and now the case is fixed for 09.10.2015 for remaining prosecution evidence.

Since the case is almost at the fag end, no ground is made out to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.
