Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the FIR No.257 dated 11.5.2011 under Sections 420/406/409/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar. The present petition was filed on 2.11.2011.

Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 submits that during the pendency of the present petition, not only the challan was presented, but the charge was also framed by the trial Court on 12.8.2014 and the case is now pending for prosecution witnesses.

Learned counsel for the State submits that though the FIR was registered under Sections 420/406/409/467/468/471 IPC, however, the charge has been framed only for the offence under Sections 406/420 IPC.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, taking into consideration that the petitioner is facing the prosecution since 2011, his presence shall remain exempted during the trial unless the same is necessarily required.

The trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
