The petitioners allegedly abetted Devinder Kumar to
commit suicide as per the allegations of his brother-in-law.

Petitioner No.1 is father-in-law, petitioner No.2 is wife,
petitioner No.3 is brother-in-law whereas petitioner No.4 is
maternal uncle-in-law of the deceased.

On the instructions of ASI Hans Raj, learned State
counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation
and that matter has been compromised amongst the family
members.

Taking into consideration the relationship of the complainant as well as that of the petitioners with the deceased, I am of the considered opinion that it is not a case of custodial interrogation. The matter would involve arguable points during trial regarding constitution of offence of abetment.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer, subject to the condition that they will join the investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence and hamper the investigation in any manner.
