Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.25 of 18.02.2014 (COMI/IIS/2015) titled as "Om Parkash versus Davinder Kumar" summoned under Sections 304-B, 313 read with Section 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 21.09.2015:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, initially, the FIR was registered under Section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) against Anju Devi alias Bawi. Petitioner has been summoned to face trial in a private complaint under Sections 304-B, 313

IPC read with Section 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion for 17.11.2015.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Magistrate and the Magistrate shall release the petitioner on interim bail subject to its satisfaction."

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioner has surrendered before the Magistrate and has furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioner, before the Magistrate, in pursuance to the order dated 21.09.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
