This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala, vide FIR No.113 dated 13.06.2015.

The petition has been rendered infructuous qua petitioner No.3 as he has already been arrested.

As regards petitioners No.1, 2 & 4, learned State counsel (on the instructions from ASI Sher Singh, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated September 21, 2015, petitioners No.1, 2 & 4 have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated September 21, 2015 is hereby made absolute qua petitioners No.1, 2 & 4, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
