The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 62 dated 07.03.2015 registered at Police Station Tripuri Town, Patiala under Section 7/13(1)(d)/8/9/12 of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

Heard.

The first bail application had been dismissed on merits on 25.05.2015, noticing the following:-

“The trial Court had dismissed the application noticing that the petitioner would influence the witnesses and the investigation. That application was moved at the early stages. Evidence is yet to start, the allegations are serious, looking at his position, he can tamper with evidence. The case is at the early stages of trial.”

Learned State counsel informs that some additional information was received and supplementary challan has been filed and no witness till date has been examined.

The trial Court had dismissed the application noticing that the petitioner would influence the witnesses. Evidence is yet to start.

Witnesses would be officials of the department he had worked in.

No case for grant of regular bail at this stage is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
