AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.110 dated 16.07.2014 registered under Sections 51/52-A/63/65 of Copy Right Act, 1957 (amendment Acts 1984 and 1994) pending in the Court of Shri Simran Singh, JMIC, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner had been regularly appearing and missed the hearing only on one day because he had noted the wrong date.

In my considered opinion, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on the next date and, in case the assertion regarding the previous appearances is correct, the petitioner would

be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
