Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners being major have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents no.4 to 7 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have

moved representation dated 29.8.2015 (Annexure P4) to respondent no.2.

Learned State counsel submits that statements of parents of the girl have been recorded and they have no objection to the marriage between the petitioners.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 – S.P., Kurukshetra to take appropriate action on the representation dated 29.8.2015 (Annexure P4) submitted by the petitioners, as warranted by law.
