Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Lakhwinder Kaur in Complaint Case No.36 dated 26.11.2014 titled as Pardip Singh Vs. Chanchal Singh pending in the court of learned JMIC, Batala.

It is submitted that a false case has been filed against the petitioner by the friend of the husband of the petitioner with whom she had strained relations.

As per allegations petitioner is alleged to have raised a *lalkara* and uttered objectionable words.

The plea is that from the allegations no offence is made out.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has since submitted herself before the trial Court and has been granted

interim bail.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by the trial Court
is made absolute.
