Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.265 dated 21.08.2015, under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 21.09.2015:-

"Notice of motion for 17.11.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub

Inspector Satbir Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 21.09.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
