This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.103 dated 27.08.2015 under Sections 120-B, 181, 420, 466, 467 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Lahori Gate, District Patiala.

Petition has already been dismissed qua petitioner No.2 on September 21, 2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh submits that pursuant to order dated September 21, 2015, petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated September 21, 2015, qua petitioner No.1, is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
