Petitioner is facing trial in a double murder case of Ravi Kumar and Rakesh Kumar. Through instant petition he seeks interim bail for a period of two weeks to enable him to participate in the last rites ceremony of his sister who has died on September 11, 2015.

In view of the nature of the allegations against the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate and expedient in the interest of justice and security to release the petitioner on interim bail, however, taking into consideration the relationship of the petitioner with the deceased, notice of motion to Advocate General, Haryana.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Rahul Mohan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner may be taken in custody on any two days between October 1, 2015 to October 15, 2015 to his house or the house of his sister at his own expenses. On both the days, he would be taken in the morning and would be brought back by 5.00 p.m. The dates opted by the petitioner may be mentioned by the petitioner in his application to the Jail Superintendent.
