Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Bharat Bhushan @ Sonu in case FIR No.234 dated 08.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana City.

As per case of the prosecution two co-accused Navdeep Singh and Birpal Singh were apprehended and found in possession of 20-20 grams each of heroin while the petitioner is alleged to have fled in car bearing No.PB-10-ET-9959.

It is contended that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner neither the alleged car belongs to the petitioner and both the aforesaid co-accused have since been granted regular bail. It is further

contended that a false case has been foisted upon the petitioner and there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Didar Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 21st of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
